OUR PROGRAMS

Supervised Visitation

In an effort to reunite families that have been disrupted by child abuse, neglect, domestic violence, or custody disputes, Parents Place provides Supervised Visitation Programs. This allows children who have been separated from their families the opportunity to maintain a relationship with their parent(s) while a permanency plan is being formulated. Children and the non-custodial parent(s) are able to spend quality time together in a safe and nurturing environment under the guidance of professionally trained staff that education, observation, provide documentation, and intervention, when necessary.

Born Learning

Born Learning is a program that promotes early learning opportunities for children by educating families and other caregivers of young children in understanding the importance of a child's early years. By encouraging action, Born Learning strives to inspire everyone in the community to do what is necessary to promote fun learning opportunities for children prior to entering school.

Community Education

Parents Place, Inc is the coordinating agency and contract administrator of the Community Education Program, a family enrichment center. This is a resource for families with children ages 0-18 and is designed to promote strong, healthy families through support, education and shared experiences by building on family strengths. Educational classes, support groups, and playgroups along with workshops and special fun nights are offered to families for a nominal commitment fee or free of charge, based on ability to pay. On site child care is provided at no cost.

Community Education offers parents and children an easy and comfortable way to learn new skills, interact with other parents, discover community resources, and find the joy and pleasure of parenting.
